#### From Tokyo Route

First, drive along the Chuo Expressway to the Okaya Junction and then get onto the Nagano Expressway. Get off the Nagano Expressway at the Matsumoto Interchange.

From there, going East along Route 158 will take you to Okuhida-Onsengo.

#### From Nagoya Route

Get on the Tokai-Hokuriku Expressway at Ichinomiya Interchange and head toward Hida-Kiyomi Interchange. At the Hida-Kiyomi Interchange, get onto the Chubu-Jukan Expressway and then get off at Takayama Interchange.

From there, going East along Route 158 will take you to Okuhida-Onsengo.

#### From Toyama Route

From the Toyama Interchange on the Hokuriku Expressway, take Route 41 to Kamioka-cho. From there, going East along Route 471 will take you to Okuhida-Onsengo.

#### From Tokyo Route

Please use the following trains for a quick and comfortable journey from Tokyo to Okuhida-Onsengo. Take the Hokuriku Shinkansen from Tokyo to Toyama. Take the JR Chuo-Line from Tokyo (or Shinjuku) to Matsumoto.

#### From Nagoya Route

From Nagoya station, take the "Wide-View Hida" on the Takayama Line (JR Tokai). Get off at Hida Takayama station.

From Hida Takayama station, take the Nouhi Bus service to Okuhida-Onsengo.

#### From Osaka(Kyoto,Kobe) Route

Please use the following trains for a quick and comfortable journey from Osaka to Okuhida-Onsengo. Take the Tokaido Shinkansen from Osaka (or Kyoto, Kobe) to Nagoya.

Change trains at Kanazawa from the JR Hokuriku Line to the Hokuriku Shinkansen and get off at Toyama. You can also use a fixed-route bus (Nohi bus) from Toyama station to the Okuhida Hot Spring Village.

#### For Express Bus Users

From Tokyo	By highway bus or limited express bus Use the Takayama / Hirayu Onsen - Shinjuku Line highway bus linking Shinjuku and Okuhida (reservation required).
From Nagoya	From Nagoya, change to the Takayama - Nagoya Line highway bus linking Nagoya and Hida-takayama (reservation required). To go towards the Okuhida Hot Spring Village from Takayama station, change to the fixed-route bus (Nohi bus) at the Takayama Nohi Bus Center.
From Matsumoto	Take the express bus from Shinshu-Matsumoto via Abo Tunnel. Takayama, Shinhotaka, Hirayu Onsen - Matsumoto Line (Nohi bus, Alpico transportation). *No reservation required.
From Toyama	From Toyama, take the Okuhida / Toyama Line highway bus linking Toyama station and Toyama airport and the Okuhida Hot

From Osaka

From Osaka, take the Kyoto / Osaka Line (Noto bus) linking Osaka / Kyoto and Hida-takayama. Take the Osaka / Kyoto - Takayama / Okuhida Onsengo nonstop bus (Chuo Kotsu Travel Club) linking Osaka / Kyoto and the Okuhida Hot Spring Village / Hida-takayama.
